Guidelines for Kids Camp 2006

- ▶ All campers shall be inspected for head lice before checking in at the registration table. **Local church personnel may not leave the camp grounds until all of their campers have passed this inspection.**
- ▶ It is highly recommended that each local church conduct their own inspection prior to leaving for camp, so as to prevent any embarrassment and disappointment upon Camp arrival.
- ▶ Should a camper be found to have head lice at the time of registration, the following steps will be taken.
