

*What's a Pastor to do when someone says,  
"I think I might be called to ministry"?*  
(as it relates to the processes leading to licensing and ordination)

1. Have the person visit the Ministry Prep page at <http://orpac.org> .
2. Have him or her download a Handbook for Christian Ministries from the link on the website or here:  
<http://nazarenpastor.org/ClergyEducation/Portals/0/Resources/USAHB.pdf>
3. Walk with the person through the section of the Handbook entitled "Stage One: The Call".
4. When you are satisfied that he or she may be called to ministry, have them register the call with the proper district personnel (see orpac.org) by having them fill in the "Registering My Call" document or form submission on the website.
5. When or if you are ready to do so, download the Local License Packet from the website, have the candidate fill out the application, and have your Church Board consider issuing a Local Minister's License.
