COMMONLY ASKED CAMP QUESTIONS

Question 1 - Where is Kellogg Springs Camp located?

Kellogg Springs Camp is owned and operated by the Oregon Pacific District Church of the Nazarene and is located in Southern Oregon. The camp sits on a very large hill in the middle of tall fir trees. The locations of building around camp are either up the hill from one another or down the hill. Walking shoes are essential! The address is: 1111 Kellogg Camp Ln, Oakland, OR 97462. The closest pharmacy, Dutch Bros, Starbucks and grocery store are 18 miles away (about 20 minutes) in the town of Sutherlin. The closest hospital and more shopping options are in Roseburg, which is about 35-40 minutes from camp.

Question 2 - What kind of lodging is at camp? Where are the bathrooms?

Kellogg Springs Camp is made up of mostly of cabin style lodging, sleeping anywhere from 6-18 people. Most of the beds are twin bunkbeds, but some cabins do have one queen size bed within the room. Some cabins have bathrooms within the cabin. Some cabins have bathrooms close by and share a large bathhouse. Besides bathrooms in certain cabins, there is a large bathhouse, bathrooms above and below the dining hall, in the activity room and in the chapel.

Question 3 - What about food? What if I have a food allergy?

Kellogg Springs Camp has a Chef who prepares your meals. She loves to share Christ's love through food. She is extremely talented and can handle even complex allergies. If you have any questions about food needs. Please contact Pastor Missy.

Question 4 - Where do I park and where do I go when I first arrive at camp?

There will be parking attendants to help guide you when you first arrive at camp. The campground is about 1 mile from the highway up a winding gravel road. Carpooling is suggested. Leave your luggage in your vehicle and head to onsite registration/check-in, which will be held near the Dining Hall (the big green building close to the circle driveway). Greeters will help guide you after you have parked. During the onsite registration process, you will be given your cabin/room assignment and guided where to take your luggage.

Question 1 - How do I pay for the weekend?

Online Payment will ask for your checking account number and routing number (these numbers can be found on your check or usually in your banking app) or credit card (extra fee required).

Your payment secures your bed (literally). Due to varied needs for beds and bathrooms, the most fair way to hold a bed for any lady is via payment. Placement in requested cabins/beds will be first come, first serve, meaning the first to register and pay will be get their requests fulfilled first.

Question 2 - How much do I pay?

\$195 for standard registration, \$170 for a teen or someone staying in an RV, \$125 for a Pastor, Pastor's wife or Pastor's daughter

Question 3- Are there Scholarships available?

There are no official scholarships. However, do not let finances be a barrier. There are people who are willing to help cover the cost of registration for others. Please reach out to your local pastor or Pastor Missy to find out about ways to pay for Women's Advance.

Question 4- I'd like to help cover other women's registration fees, how can I do that?

We have included an option of donating for another women's registration on the payment screen. The suggested donation is \$50, but you are welcome to donate as much or as little as the Holy Spirit directs. Thank you for being willing to empower the women of ORPAC to move forward in a purposeful way!

OTHER QUESTIONS

Question 1 - What I need to cancel my registration?

Please notify the Laura Lehman (WA Treasurer) and Pastor Missy Humber as soon as you know you cannot attend as planned (refunds are calculated from the time the information reaches the Treasurer). Refunds are issued based on the following. If there is some sort of special circumstances involved please also contact Pastor Missy.

REFUND POLICY:

- ·Cancellations made at least 21 full days prior to the start of camp will receive a FULL refund.
- ·Cancellations made at least 14 full days prior to the start of camp will receive an 80% refund.
- ·Cancellations made between 14 days and the start of camp will receive a 50% refund.

Question 2 - What time do I need to arrive? What time is the event over?

Arrive anytime after 4pm on Friday night. Onsite registration will be held from 4-6pm and dinner will be served at 6:30pm in the Dining Hall. The Welcome Session will begin at 7:30pm in the Chapel. Join us as soon as you can on Friday night. Saturday morning will include a worship session and two breakout sessions. Saturday afternoon is free time and then Saturday evening is more worship and fellowship time. Sunday morning we will worship together again, pack up and leave around 11-11:30am.

Question 3 - What if getting around camp will be difficult for me?

It is our desire to make camp as accessible as we can. We acknowledge that the unique terrain will be difficult for some. We will make available "taxi" service around camp for Chapel and some free time activities. We will do our best to make lodging placements easier for those we know might have mobility struggles. Please be sure to mark the appropriate boxes on the registration form or leave a comment in the section at the bottom of the form.

Question 4 - Do I get a say in my cabin placement?
